RESEARCHING & SIGNPOSTING FOR SUPPORT:

Recognising the urgent need for assistance, the academy staff promptly sprang into action by researching and identifying various sources of support for David. They provided him with invaluable information, guiding him to resources that could provide housing assistance and other forms of support crucial to his well-being.

Aware of the urgency of the situation, the academy not only granted David the time to visit support sources but also generously allowed him to use their phone, enabling him to make the necessary calls and appointments. DNSA also facilitated David's journey by helping him connect with a dedicated support worker. This union ensured that David had a professional advocate who could guide him through the complexities of accessing essential services, navigate potential hurdles, and provide the emotional support needed during this challenging time.

PROVIDING BASIC NEEDS:

Understanding David's immediate needs, and the importance of dignity and self-esteem, the academy allowed him to arrive early on-site to wash and change clothes, ensuring he felt comfortable and confident as he pursued his education. Additionally, the academy's staff provided food parcels to David, ensuring he had access to nourishment easing the burden of acquiring meals during his transitional period.

They provided essential items such as underwear, a coat, track pants, and t-shirts, empowering him with the confidence to focus on his education and rebuild his life. Moreover, the academy directors, committed to providing a safe and inclusive environment, invested in a washing machine on-site, further enhancing the academy's facilities to cater to the needs of its diverse student body.
